Alberta Liberals to nominate three more Calgary candidates tonight

Calgary – The Alberta Liberals will nominate three more candidates tonight to run in Calgary constituencies in the next provincial election. Former Calgary Herald reporter Laura Shutiak will be nominated to run in Calgary-Fish Creek, lawyer John Roggeveen will be nominated to run in Calgary-Shaw, and teacher Lori Czerwinski will be nominated to run in Calgary-Lougheed.

Roggeveen and Czerwinski both ran as Alberta Liberal candidates in the 2004 election, while Shutiak is throwing her hat in the ring for the first time. “I’m running for the Alberta Liberals because it is time for a change,” explains Shutiak, a mother of three young children. “I want our current prosperity to last long enough for my kids to enjoy it, and with the way things are going now, I’m not sure that it will. We need a fresh start in this province to get things back on track.”

Czerwinski notes that there is a renewed sense of excitement in the Alberta Liberal team in the south Calgary constituencies. “I look forward to working alongside John and Laura. Together, we will present a fresh, new perspective to the voters in our constituencies.”
