Alberta Liberal Leader Kevin Taft working twice as hard as Ed Stelmach in final week of 2008 campaign

Edmonton – Alberta Liberal Leader Kevin Taft logged almost 3,700 kilometres travelling around Alberta since Monday.

By comparison, PC Leader Ed Stelmach hardly left his Tory bubble of PC campaign headquarters in logging only around 1,534 kilometres since Monday.

The last six days has seen Taft campaigning in the following communities, in order: Edmonton, Red Deer, Calgary, Lethbridge, Medicine Hat, Edmonton, Grande Cache, Grande Prairie, Wabasca-Desmarais, Fort McMurray, Red Deer, Calgary, Edmonton, and Thorsby.

Total kilometres travelled: 3,690

Here's where Stelmach visited, in order, in the last six days of the campaign: Calgary, Edmonton, Lethbridge, Didsbury, Red Deer, Edmonton, and Calgary.

Total kilometres travelled: 1,534

“This travel data neatly sums up the key difference between Kevin Taft and Ed Stelmach,” said Alberta Liberal campaign manager Kieran Leblanc. “Taft and the Alberta Liberals are willing to work hard and open up to Albertans in all corners of the province. Stelmach and the PCs are just coasting along, oblivious to the change for which Albertans are clamouring.”

Throughout the 2008 election campaign, the Alberta Liberals have regularly purchased carbon offsets to compensate for greenhouse-gas emissions occurring from its operations and travel.
